

Basic Citation Guidelines

Adding a citation to your reference page:

For all research papers it is extremely important that you cite all references accurately. This keeps you in compliance with copyright law and rules on academic honesty.

Basic Format for Internet Citation

Name of business or website. (date retrieved). *Page or article name*.
Retrieved from: exact web address of page or article

Example:

Haymarket Cafe. (2011). *Menu*. Retrieved from:
<http://www.haymarketcafe.com/menu.html>

Basic Format for Book Citation

Last name, first & middle initial. (year). *Whole title of book*. Publisher Name and location.

Example:

Jones, G. R. (2007). *Introduction to business: how companies create value for people*. Boston: McGraw-Hill/Irwin.

Basic Format for an Electronic Image

Author (Role of Author). (Year image was created). Title of work [Type of work],
Retrieved
Month Day, Year, from: URL (address of web site)
